

Privacy Statement (as at May 2018)

§ 1 Information regarding the collection of personal data

(1) Hereafter please note information regarding the collection of personal data whilst using our website. Personal data includes all personal information like, for example, names, addresses, email addresses and user behaviour.

(2) GMEINDER MANAGEMENT GMBH, Anton-Gmeinder-Str. 9-19, 74821 Mosbach, info@gmeinder.de is the responsible contact as per article 4, paragraph 7, of the EU Data Protection Act. Our privacy officer may be contacted at 'datenschutzbeauftragter@gmeinder.de' or via our postal address by adding 'The Privacy Officer' to the address.

(3) On contacting us via email your data (email address and, possibly, name and telephone number) is stored in order to enable us to answer your questions. Once this information is not required anymore it is then deleted or access is restricted in the event of mandatory data retention.

(4) In the event of having to refer back to our service providers with regard to various applications offered or if we wish to use your information for promotional purposes you shall be informed in detail as mentioned below. The criteria for the storage period is also specified.

§ 2 Legal representation

(1) You may exercise the following rights regarding your personal data:

- the right of access to information
- the right to correction and deletion of inaccurate data
- the right to reduced access and processing
- the right of appeal against processing
- the right to data portability

(2) Additionally, you have the right to lodge a complaint against us and the processing of your personal data by us.

§ 3 Storage of personal data during your visit to our website

(1) To evaluate the use of the website when you do not register or information is received through other channels, only the personal data transferred to us via your browser is collected. If you wish to view our website, we only store technical data required to display our website and to ensure stability and security (based on art. 6 para. 1 pg. 1 lit. f DS-GVO of the EU Data Protection Act):

- IP-Address
- Date and time of request
- Time zone variation to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
- Request content (specific page)
- Access status/HTTP-Statuscode
- Amount of information accessed and transmitted
- Website with access request
- Browser
- Operational system and graphical interface
- Language and software version of browser

(2) Additionally, data in form of cookies are stored on your pc when using our website. Cookies are small files that are normally stored on the hard drive of your computer by the browser and used to facilitate online navigation. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. They are used to make the internet more user friendly and efficient.

(3) Use of cookies:

a) This website uses different kinds of cookies whose functionality and extent are described as follows:

- Transient Cookies (see b)
- Persistent Cookies (see c).

b) Transient cookies are deleted automatically when closing the browser. These include in particular the session cookies. They store a so-called session-ID which is used to allocate various access requests by your browser to one common internet session. Thus your pc is recognized on returning to our website. Session cookies are deleted when logging out or closing the browser.

c) Persistent cookies are deleted automatically after a specified period, which may differ according to cookie type. You can delete cookies anytime in the security settings of your browser.

d) Your browser settings can be configured as desired thereby either accepting third-party cookies or declining the use of cookies in general. Therefore, we have to point out that this website might have restricted functionality.
